ABOUT RAWDANCE

Founded in San Francisco in 2004, **RAWdance is an award-winning, contemporary dance company that transforms theaters, public places, and virtual spaces through a mix of performance, curation, and collaboration**. Under founding co-artistic directors, Ryan T. Smith, Wendy Rein, the company's nuanced, charged dances pose provocative questions ranging from the broadly social to the intimately personal. The *SF Chronicle* describes the company as "witty, whip-smart, and beautiful to watch." *Critical Dance* calls RAWdance a "rare treasure" that "combines choreographic excellence, innovative structures, groundbreaking concepts and impeccable performances." In 2019, the company expanded beyond San Francisco to include a second location, New York's Hudson Valley.

RAWdance creates adventurous, thoughtful and welcoming programming that challenges what contemporary dance is, where it happens, who it includes, and the role it plays in our lives. The company champions the power of movement as an indispensable source of connection and a visceral medium to illuminate the issues of our time.

COMPANY BASICS

- RAWdance is a non-profit 501(c)(3) corporation.
- The current board includes six standing board members and an advisory board. The co-ADs are permanent, ex-officio board members.
- The team includes two full-time co-ADs, a managing director and a half-time program manager.
- The company also employs part-time dancers and a CONCEPT series Coordinator and collaborates with other creative professionals on a part-time employment or contract basis, depending on the role.
- In 2020, RAWdance completed a three-year strategic plan to guide the company's growth and development over the next several years.

YOUR PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES AS A RAWDANCE BOARD MEMBER

- Support and focus the organization on its defined strategic mission and goals.
- Monitor the financial health of the organization and ensure that it has stable and diverse funding sources to achieve its goals.
- Participate in identifying and soliciting funding sources to ensure the mission is met.
- Volunteer for performances and special events.
- Attend several RAWdance performances (may include informal works-in-progress) per year, and attend (for context) a few non-RAWdance performances.
- Provide contacts for RAWdance fundraising events and campaigns.
- Recruit and orient new board members and assess board performance.

- Promote the visibility of RAWdance in the community.
- Board members serve a three-year term, and, by mutual agreement, may serve for up to three successive terms with a maximum nine-year term limit. Officers are elected annually for one-year terms.
- Board meetings are currently held on a monthly basis. Committee or task force meetings are scheduled as needed, depending on the time of year or issues that need to be addressed.

QUALIFICATIONS OF AN IDEAL RAWDANCE BOARD CANDIDATE

- A passion for the performing arts and a commitment to supporting the arts community.
- A commitment to equity and anti-racism.

- An affinity for cultivating relationships and building consensus among diverse individuals.

- Ideally, board members have professional experience in one or more of the following areas: community organization, finance, legal, philanthropy, nonprofit fund development, marketing, publicity, event planning, and/or operations management.
- Capacity and desire to commit an average of five hours per month on RAWdance board work, including advance preparation for meetings and community outreach.
